accomodations

Female students will be staying in a lakefront home while male students are staying in cabins approximately 3 miles away. We have also rented two additional houses for the week to accommodate more students this year. All bedding is supplied for your students, so there is no need to bring pillows, blankets, or sleeping bags. The lakefront home will be our main gathering space throughout the week. This is where meals, morning services, and lake/recreation time will be held each day.

Lake Time

Each day, we will have several hours of time out on the lake! Activities include tubing, fishing, swimming, wakeboarding, etc.! Students will have access to 5 boats during lake time. Experienced boat drivers who are familiar with Lake Eufaula will be joining us for the entire week for the sole purpose of driving boats. Students and adult leaders will NOT be operating a watercraft. In accordance with Oklahoma Law, every student under 13 must wear a life jacket at all times while on a boat or dock. EVERY student and leader, regardless of age, MUST wear a life jacket while swimming or participating in any watersport activity.



WHAT NOT TO BRING


Nail Polish
